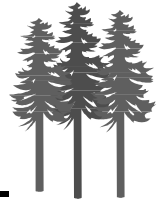

Correct Putting alignment will help you putt your best. It is really easy to get misaligned because when you stand over the golf ball, you are perpendicular to your target line. If you could see yourself from behind your target line while you were setting up, it would be much easier to line up correctly. The way you stand over the golf ball while setting up can easily give a false illusion and thus cause alignment problems with putting. When you are not aligned proper you must compensate your motion to make a putt. Anytime you compensate it hard to be consistent. When you practice either put a chalk line down to help with alignment or place two club to aide in alignment. Once you get aligned you will make more putts.
